BPI Global Investment Fund is managed by Caixabank Asset Management Luxembourg S.A.

Objectives and investment policy

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to provide Unitholders with long-term capital appreciation, based on risk spreading and future potential growth.

The Sub-Fund will principally invest in equity securities of companies belonging to the Euro Zone and companies that have their main activities in the Euro Zone and with market value over 5 thousand million Euro. The target medium annual value of the instruments issued by Euro Zone Companies and companies that have their main activities in the Euro Zone will be equal or superior to two thirds of the medium net asset value of the Sub-Fund for the same period.

The Sub-Fund aims to produce returns by investing in multiple asset classes including non voting preferred stocks, bonds with acquisition rights, convertible bonds, warrants or any other financial instruments that attribute a subscription right, are convertible or have their performance linked to a basket of units and/or indexes.

The Sub-Fund may also use Derivatives for the purposes of hedging and efficient portfolio management. The Sub-Fund will not enter into funded and unfunded total return swaps.

The Sub-Fund will not enter into SFTs. Should the Sub-Fund enter into SFTs in the future, the Prospectus will be amended accordingly prior to such use.

The Sub-Fund may also hold ancillary cash.

The Sub-fund pursues an actively-managed investment strategy.

The Sub-fund refers to the following Benchmark: MSCI EMU Large Caps Total Return.

The benchmark is indicated for information purposes only, and the Fund manager does not intend to track it or to limit the Sub-fund's portfolio to the constituents of the Benchmark. The Fund can deviate from this benchmark.

The Benchmark is solely used as a reference to compare the performance of the Sub-fund. The Sub-fund's investment objective is not to track the performance of the Benchmark.

The base currency of the Sub-Fund is the EUR.

BPI Euro Large Caps – R units are non-distributing: any income generated by the Sub-Fund is reinvested to grow the value of units of the Sub-fund.

Recommendation: this fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 3 to 5 years.

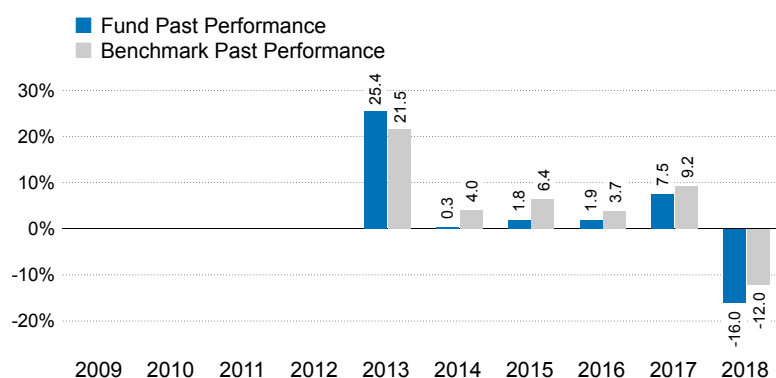
